



Updated - COVID-19 Playing Regulations

- All Golfers must practice Social Distancing at all times on Golf Course.
- Golfers should arrive no earlier than 15 minutes to check in for their tee time. Exceptions to this would only be if they're wanting to hit balls on the driving range.
- No group gatherings in front of clubhouse or parking lot before or after round of golf. **This applies to all League players as well.**
- Tee Times should be booked in groups of 2 – 4 players. Five-some's will be allowed but will be at the discretion of the Pro Shop. Any Five-some not maintaining the proper pace of play will be broken up into a two-some and three-some. Six-some's or more are never allowed unless it is a club run function. Singles will be allowed to book tee times and go out by themselves during slow times on the tee sheet. A slow time would be considered a time when no one has teed off on the 1st Hole for at least 30 minutes. Single tee times to play by yourself can only be made on the day single is wanting to play and must be booked. Singles wanting to book days in advance will only be allowed to book if there is a 2-some or 3-some on the tee sheet that they can be booked in with.
- Walk-ons are not recommended, all players wanting to play should book a tee time. Letting groups play through is allowed please ensure social distancing guidelines are followed. Reminder Home owners along or near course are not allowed to jump on course at any time. Please make sure to cancel your tee time or inform Pro Shop of any changes to you tee time at least 2 hours prior if possible.
- Tee time intervals will be 10 minutes apart. Pro Shop staff will inform players when their group is allowed to go to 1st tee and start. All names of your group should be given to pro shop staff before you tee off.
- Greens will have foam in bottom of cup. This way the ball doesn't fall in past the top of cup. The flag stick is not to be touched at any time. Please pick ball up with your fingers making sure not to touch any part of the cup or flag. Please take extra care in maintaining social distancing on Tees & Greens.
- No Sharing of Clubs, Golf Balls or any other equipment used for Golf.
- Golf Carts should be single rider only but is at the discretion of the golfer. If golfers decide to ride together they may but it is their choice.
- Club Golf Carts will be sanitized after each use we would encourage private cart owners to do the same.
- Member Cart sheds will be opened up by Pro Shop staff at the start of the day and closed at the end of the day so there will be no need for members to open and close any doors. Please only touch your cart when in cart shed and remember the Golf Club is not responsible for any lost items in Cart Sheds please don't leave keys or personal items in your carts.
- There will be no ball washers, rakes and benches put out on the course at this time. All permanent benches on Golf Course are not to be used.
- For this season we will have the portable bathroom open on Hole # 4 and the bathroom facility by Hole # 12 & 15 open. Bathroom on Hole # 9 will still closed for remainder of season. One person at a time allowed in bathrooms on course and by Pro Shop. These will be cleaned on a regular basis.
- Pro Shop is open but is restricted to a max 4 customers at any time. If there is already 4 customers in Pro Shop other customers should wait outside of building. Only 2 people at a time may be standing in Hallway if they are waiting to use bathrooms by Pro Shop. If you don't need anything from Pro Shop or don't need to use washroom please stay outside.
- Putters Restaurant is open. 6 People max per table. If you are wanting food between nines it is recommended you call in and order at Hole # 8 Tee Box so it's ready when you come off Hole # 9. This will help avoid back-ups on Hole # 10 and will help maintain pace of play.
- **If you are feeling sick please stay home.**

The Bridges at Claresholm is taking Covid-19 very seriously. Anyone not following the above regulations will be given an immediate two week suspension.

2nd infractions will result in a one month suspension.
